TOURISM AUTHORITY OF THAILAND EYES SUSTAINABLE GREEN STRATEGY

The Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT) has revealed its renewed commitment to promote the country as a 'sustainable destination', championing environmental conservation. TAT's Governor, Thapanee Kiatphaiboon, unveiled this green strategy, aiming to familiarise international travellers with Thailand's proactive stance towards embracing global sustainability trends.

Thailand, known for its vibrant culture, exotic cuisine, and picturesque landscapes, is now determined to enhance its tourism appeal by focusing on sustainability. Thapanee highlighted that the country is striving to evolve into a high-value and sustainable tourism hotspot. This shift comes in response to the environmental challenges the country has been grappling with, including wildfires in northern Thailand that have disrupted tourism over prolonged periods.



TAT's green strategy, aptly named 'Sustainably Now', is designed to overhaul the tourism sector by aligning with Sustainable Tourism Goals (STGs). These goals are in line with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals, a testament to Thailand's commitment to global sustainability standards.

CABLE CHAOS NEAR PHUKET AIRPORT: THEFT AND DAMAGE PROBE TAKES OFF

Phuket Provincial Police are accelerating the investigation into the recent theft and damage of power and communication cables near Phuket International Airport. The cables, located by the road leading to the aircraft control tower, were targeted by unknown culprits who managed to cut and steal them, leading to damages amounting to 50,200 baht.

The investigation is being led by Police Major General Sermphan Sirikong, the Phuket Provincial Police Commander, and Sakhu Police Chief Police Colonel Salan Santisasanakul. The theft came to light after a meeting with local key figures, including Phongchai Munrin, Director of the Phuket Air Traffic Control Centre, who confirmed that the power cables were stolen overnight on August 25.

CPN PLANS 3 BILLION BAHT EXPANSION OF PHUKET CONDOS

Central Pattana (CPN), a company listed on the Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET), announced its intentions to introduce two additional phases to its condominium project, Phyll Phuket, near Central Phuket Floresta. The Phuket condos expansion, which includes nearly 700 units worth a total of 3 billion baht, is set to launch in the forthcoming year. This decision is motivated by the consistent demand for condos in Phuket, primarily fuelled by the thriving tourism sector.

Kree Dejchai, the President of Residential Business at CPN, revealed that the Phuket property market has demonstrated significant growth since the previous year. This upward trend is attributed to the robust demand from both foreign investors and local buyers.

PHUKET URGES SMALL HOTELS TO OBTAIN A LICENCE AHEAD OF ANTICIPATED 2.19 MILLION TOURISTS

Phuket is gearing up for the high season by encouraging **small hotel** operators to **obtain a licence**. This move is part of the city's preparation to host over 10,000 tourists daily, equating to 2.19 million visitors annually.

The Phuket Boutique Accommodation Consortium (BAC) held a seminar on September 7 to advocate for a ministerial regulation that was issued by the Department of Public Works and Town and Country Planning of the Interior Ministry back in June. This regulation adjusted the criteria required to obtain a hotel licence.

Deputy Governor of Phuket Danai Sunantarod expressed that the hotel licence changes provide a favourable opportunity for small hoteliers to legally register their businesses and open up their establishments for public agency inspections.
