TRAFFY FONDUE: PHUKET LAUNCHES ENGLISH APP TO ASSIST FOREIGNERS

An English language-enabled version of the Traffy Fondue application has been launched by the provincial office of Phuket, Thailand. This platform has been developed to assist foreign visitors in airing their grievances about local environmental conditions and public services.

The Phuket Governor, Narong Woonciew, announced yesterday that the application has been well-received by residents seeking an expedited resolution to common issues they encounter daily. The governor explained that the system was procured from the National Electronics and Computer Technology Center (Nectec) of the National Science and Technology Development Agency (NSTDA) on December 19 last year, to serve as a conduit for processing complaints. Since its inception, the application has seen a total of 3,122 complaints registered, with 60%, or 1,887 of these grievances having been addressed so far.



The Traffy Fondue system has been successfully implemented not only in Bangkok but in other provinces as well, such as Nakhon Ratchasima, Ubon Ratchathani, and Chai Nat.

Phuket's Chamber of Commerce President is keenly awaiting the immediate action of Thailand's 30th Prime Minister, Srettha Thavisin. There are a myriad of pressing issues regarding Phuket projects waiting to be addressed.

Kongsak Khupongsakorn, confident in his province's ongoing economic development, is ready to collaborate with all political parties. Regardless of who assumes the role of prime minister or even local representatives, he is eager to reflect the current myriad of issues to the Cabinet.

"We hope he's ready to get to work immediately. We have numerous stalled projects in Phuket and other Andaman provinces, waiting for the Cabinet or the prime minister's assistance."

CHINESE ECONOMIC WOES DAMPEN BOOKINGS FOR THAI TOURISM SECTOR

Tourism operators indicated a slowdown in forward bookings from China for the upcoming Golden Week holiday in October due to a challenging economic climate.

A representative from the Tourism Council of Thailand, Surawat Akaraworamat, revealed that a sluggish economic rebound and potential deflation are having far-reaching effects on disposable income for prospective tourists from the Chinese mainland.

"Travel agents have reported slower booking than usual for China National Day, one of the longest holidays in that country."

PT'S WALLET PLAN TO START BEFORE APRIL

The Pheu Thai Party said on Thursday the 10,000-baht digital wallet policy would be implemented before April next year and warned people not to fall victim to scammers luring them to click malicious links to access the handouts.

Pheu Thai deputy secretary-general Paopoom Rojanasakul said the 10,000-baht digital wallet is expected to be ready for launch in the first half of next year, and the party will try its best to roll it out before April.

He said the 10,000-baht digital wallet will not be part of the Pao Tang wallet and stressed that links being circulated to supposed 10,000-baht digital wallets are scams and not related to the party's policy because the Pheu Thai-led government is still being formed.
