THAILAND REMOVES VISAS FOR CHINESE VISITORS TO BOOST TOURISM



BANGKOK — Starting next week, Chinese nationals will be able to visit Thailand without a visa, as part of new Prime Minister Srettha Thavisin's strategy to boost the country's economy.

Beginning September 25, nationals from China and Kazakhstan can enter the kingdom under a temporary visa exemption scheme for 30 days. The waiver is due to expire at the end of February.

The prospect of more tourism has excited hotel groups and professionals, who hope Thailand will welcome more visitors from China.

"China pre-pandemic used to be one of our top countries that would come into our hotel," said Ranjeet Viswanathan, director of sales & marketing at the Hyatt Regency Phuket Resort. "Before, I think almost 18 to 20% of our business was coming from China, [we were] heavily dependent especially with the tour groups. Bookings right now, China makes up for about 5% of my business."

PHUKET HOTELS COLLABORATE WITH ONWR TO TACKLE WATER CRISIS AND BOOST SUSTAINABLE TOURISM

Facing a critical water shortage, the Office of the National Water Resources (ONWR) devised a strategy to collaborate with Phuket hotels, launching an initiative to decrease water utilisation in the tourism industry. Surasee Kittimonthon, the ONWR secretary-general, highlighted the escalating water crisis in the popular Thai resort island, marked by inadequate water supply and treatment issues.

With the tourist count expected to rise, the water demand is anticipated to intensify, thereby exacerbating the crisis. One of the proposed solutions to mitigate these shortages during drought periods is to convert canals into water storage areas, rather than allowing the water to run off into the sea.

RISE IN EXPATRIATE RESIDENCE IN THAILAND PROMPTS TOURISM BENEFITS PLAN



Thailand's popularity as a residence of choice for expatriates and remote workers is on the rise. As per the data from the Employment Department and Colliers Thailand, the first quarter of this year saw 156,596 expatriates, with over half based in Bangkok.

The leading nationalities were Japanese, Chinese, and Indian last year. However, recent reports show an increased interest among Chinese nationals in purchasing condominium units in Thailand.

In response to this expatriate residence trend, the Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT) is planning to offer benefits specifically catered towards this segment next year. As the tourism trend shifts towards longer stays post-pandemic, operators are exploring ways to engage this demographic

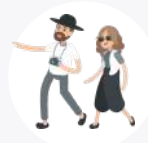

Hotel business operator Sentiment Index

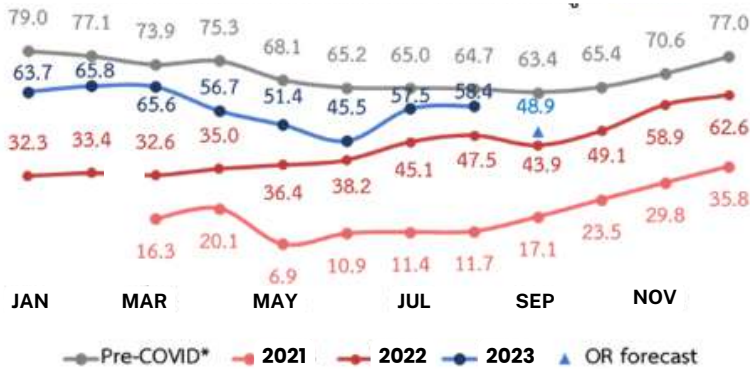

OCCUPANCY RATE

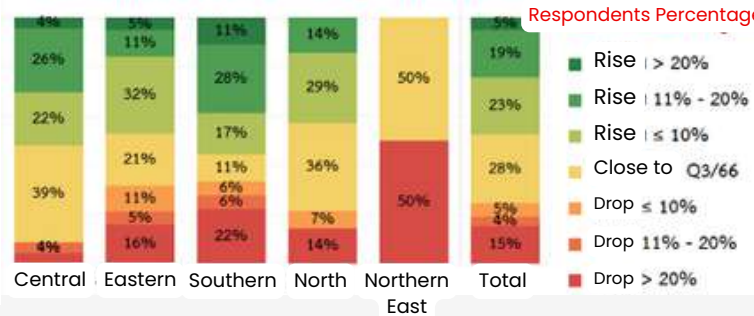
The average occupancy rate in August 2023 is 58%. Forecast average occupancy rate in September is 48.9%
