# HIGHER AIRFARES HOBBLE CHINESE MARKET REVIVAL

- According to the Tourism Authority of Thailand released that the average airfare for flights between Thailand and China remains 1.5 times higher than pre-pandemic prices, while for secondtier cities fares have surged 200% which means low-priced tours cannot return.
- TAT governor said even though average airfares for every Chinese city are still higher than before the pandemic.
- Ticket prices for March and April have doubled for secondary cites without direct flights as the reopening only began this year and the flow of passenger still weak in the first 2 months.
- The average spending per Chinese traveler increased as more expensive travel costs prompted them to consider longer stays of 5-10 days, according to dragon Trail research
- The structure of post-pandemic Chinese travel will see individual trips dominate the market outpacing mass tour groups, which have yet to resume.





#### THAILAND IS SET TO BECOME THE NUMBER ONE DESTINATION FOR INDIAN WEDDINGS IN 2023

- Before covid spread, Thailand welcomed over 400 Indian couples who marry in Thailand, the main target group was millionaires.
- Phuket tourist Association said the trend of Indian tourist groups increases as they want to travel in the Andaman area, including Phuket, Phang Nga, and Krabi, especially those who want to have a wedding in Phuket, most of them come in a group of at least 50-150 people.
- Weddings are popularly organized in five-star hotels near the seaside as Indians like convenience, and a good atmosphere, traveling from India to Phuket takes only 5 better than going to Singapore, Malaysia, or Mandeep which is expensive and India also has a direct flight to Phuket.
- Indian weddings in Thailand can cost 10 million to 30 million baht, although it looks like a high cost but cheaper 2-3 times compared to India.

- A local immigration chief in Phuket province has revealed that over 7,000 Russians have sought to extend their stay in Phuket.
- There are many Russian tourists who obtain visas to stay in Phuket for not more than 90 days (3 months), and some have opted for temporary residence in the districts of Rawai and Chalong.
- He added others are seeking to extend their stay in the capital district followed by Thalang and Kathu.
- Besides the reason for escaping the war in Ukraine, the beautiful destinations and great weather is one reason why they want to extend their stay.

### **WEEKLY THAILAND'S TOURISM** SITUATION

Economics Tourism and Sports Division assessing the state of Thai tourism at the beginning of the year is still trend continued, Thailand received 544,5013 foreign visitors in the previous week (20 - 26 Feb) accounting 5.13 percent increase from the week before the previous week.

Middle Eastern tourists and Malaysian tend to decrease due to Muslims entering Ramadan from late March until late April.



Tourism sector in many regions continue to grow up, although there are obstacles from the problem of labor shortage, Russia - Ukraine war including conflict between China - USA, which be affect to fuel prices and the cost of living.



Average airfare from China to Thailand higher for March and April for every Chinese city is still higher than before the pandemic.
